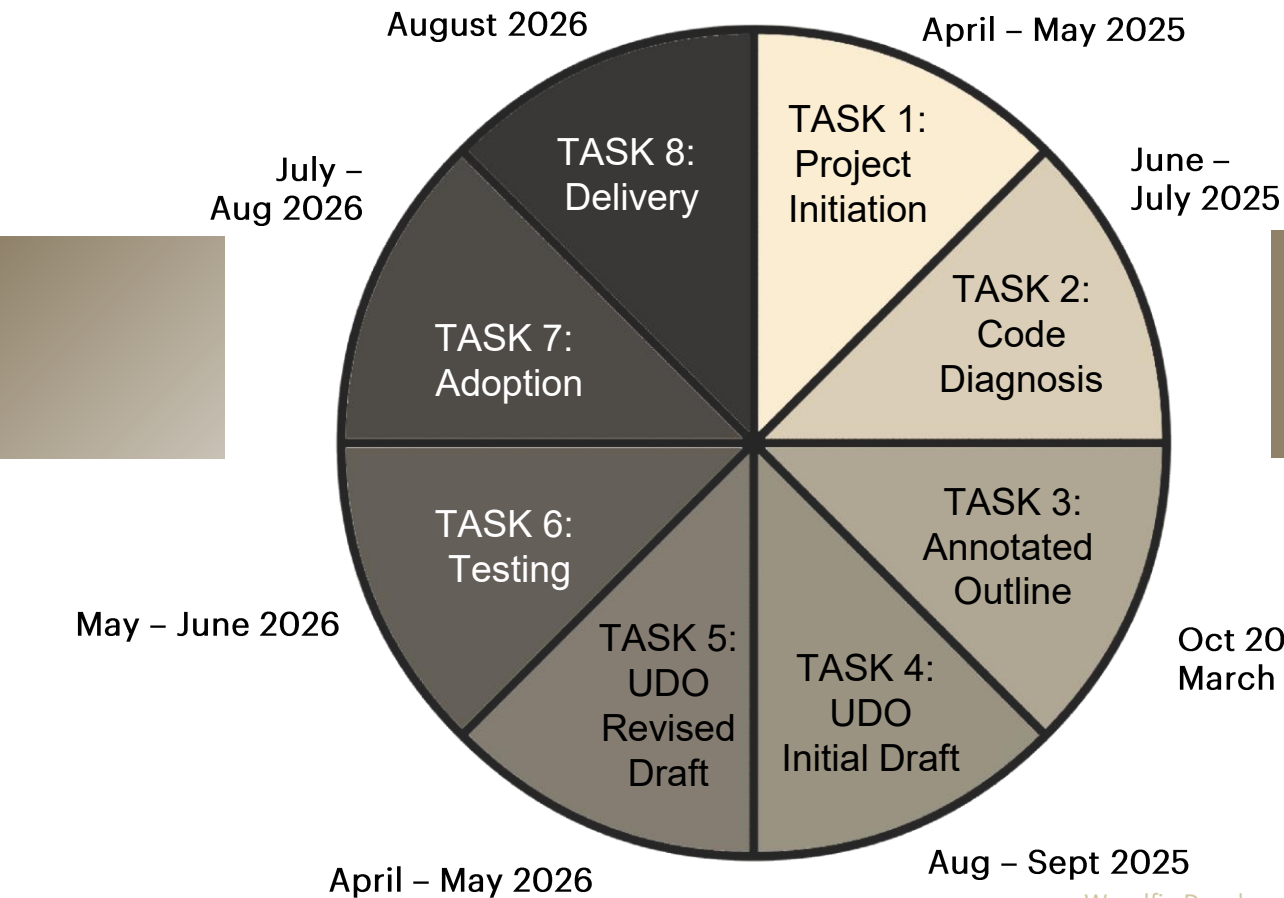
## Update Districts
